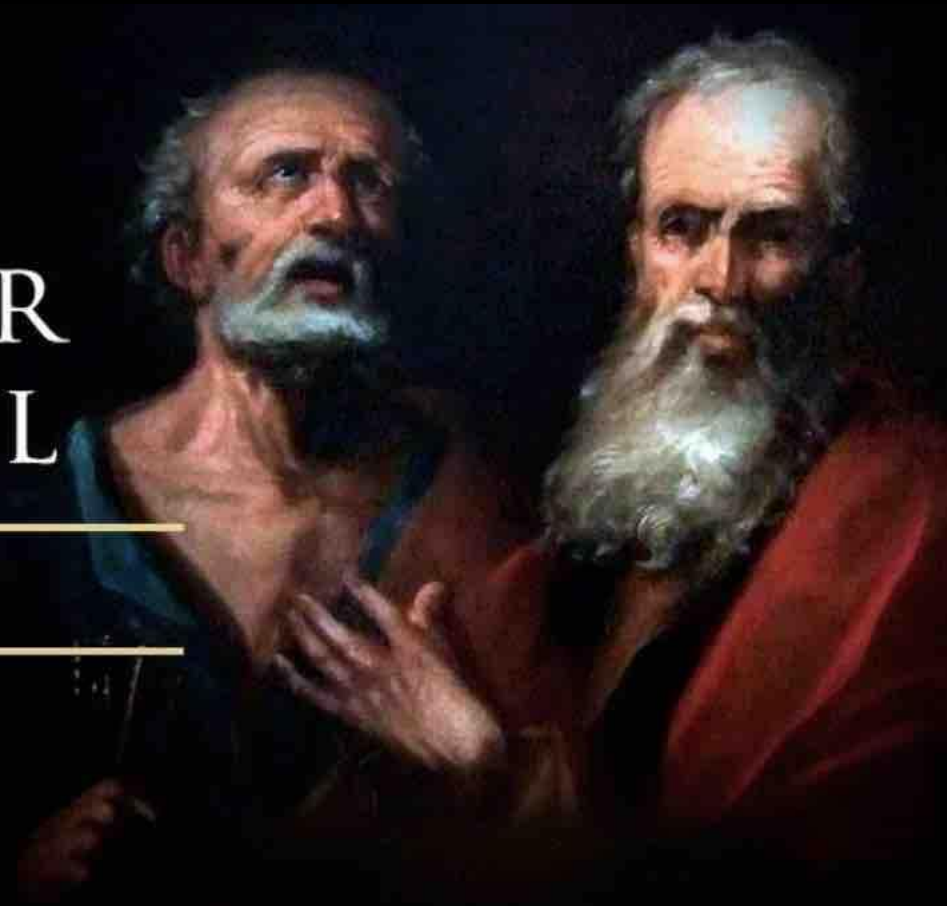


STS. PETER AND PAUL
